Lunch: Reduced \$.40- Reg. \$2.60

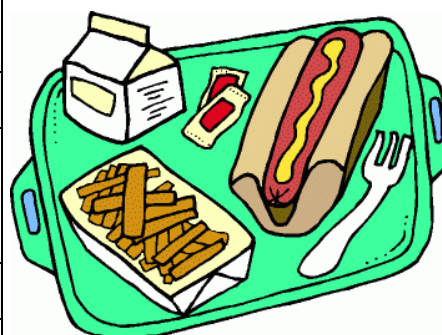
Adult Breakfast: \$2.00
